

This hymn can be sung either in two parts or straight through. In the latter case, the chorus is sung only once between verses 2 and 3.

Before the Baptism:

- 1 Hemmed in by sin, we turn to you down by the Red Sea shore; see, the waves part; you lead us through, our failing hope restore.
- 2 We hear your voice, "Come, follow me, I have a task for you. Bring all mankind home to my font; my work is your work too."

After the Baptism:

- 3 Marked by your cross, led by your light, washed in your water clear, named with your name, we face the world freed from all dread and fear.
- 4 Bathed in your love, we hear your voice: "On you my Spirit rests; go through the world, born to new life, then come, in heaven my guests."
